Welcome

Time to Center

Our ears are full.

All week, voices on our screens vie for our precious attention,
and keep us afraid.

Voices in our community cry out for justice;

Voices inside us can tell distorted truths.

As we ground ourselves for worship,
let's make space for beautiful, sacred silence

Get comfortable in your seat, and take a big breath.

simply let it float away. We'll enjoy one minute of quiet,
and then I'll invite you back.
